

*The water plants installed in the villages of Sujathanagar and Motamarri in Khammam district, and Pedda Srirampuram in Srikakulam district have two goals: provision of clean drinking water to nearly 1600 students at four schools and also some households in these villages; waste water from the plants is piped to toilets and is utilized for their proper use and maintenance.*

*An additional feature of these installations is the creation of a fund with equal contributions by the school/village & TELSAs for maintenance of the water plant and the toilets. Interest from this fund is to be used for such maintenance. A further feature of these installations is a provision for the school to sell surplus water to villagers at Rs.5 per 20 liters.*
